Frank Mundus was born in Long Branch, New Jersey in 1925. He started shark fishing in Montauk in 1951. When he first started, he called it "Monster Fishing," his way of attracting customers. In 1964, Mundus brought into Montauk a 4,500 lb. white shark, the largest white to be caught commercially (by harpoon) in this area. The largest great white he caught on rod and reel was in August 1986, weighing 3,427 lbs., with Donnie Braddick as the angler. During his fifty years as a fisherman, he has appeared on David Letterman and Larry King (the TV shows, not the people), and has written the book Fifty Years a Hooker. He is working on a photo story on the capture of the 3,427 lb. great white caught off Montauk. Frank Mundus is one of the last surviving witnesses of the aftermath of the 1951 Pelican disaster, when he and Capt. Carl Forsberg Sr. helped tow the *Pelican* into Montauk harbor. He is the model for the character Quint in Jaws, although the one in the movie is much better looking.

## About Friends of Erin
